The government of Victoria undertook to supply gas to regional towns in Gippsland. Jemena (formerly Alinta Asset Management) was awarded the contract to take gas from the Bass Gas onshore facility to the South Gippsland Regional towns of Korumburra, Leongatha and Wonthaggi.

Wasco was engaged to construct the three DN150 sections of pipeline and end of line facilities and offtakes.

The pipelines run through some of the richest dairy farms in the country and over undulating hilly country with construction challenges.

The pipeline system is 63km in total length and was commissioned in 2007.
